

ABSTRACT SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

ABSTRACT SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

- Language: ENGLISH.
- Length: max 3000 characters – spaces and symbols included. Abstracts NOT complying with this requirement will NOT BE taken into consideration.
- The abstract text must NOT include the title, authors or affiliation (the latter information will be filled out during the online submission process).
- Abstract must be submitted as text only (no tabs, images or graphics allowed).

HOW TO PROCEED:

- Read carefully the requirements and conference topics.
- Download the abstract template (Word format).
- Insert your abstract text, as required.
- Fill-out the submission form with your information, as well as including those of the co-authors. You will need to identify who will be the “presenting author”, which will be underlined in the program.
- Select one of the proposed topic areas.
- Select type of presentation (oral or poster).
 - Unfortunately we cannot guarantee that you will be given your preferred presentation option due to time limitations. The scientific committee will make the final decision regarding which abstracts will be selected for oral and poster communication.
 - The time limit for oral communications is 8 min, which will be followed by 2 min of questions/comments.
 - For those abstracts submitted for poster communication, the best abstracts based on scientific merit may be selected to give a brief presentation (3 min) during the poster session.
- Select if you would like your abstract to be evaluated for one of the Awards (SCS Young Investigator Award, ESNS Young Investigator Award, SCS Applied Science Award). See below for more detail.
- Upload your abstract in the selected field and finalize the procedure.
- After submission you will receive a confirmation email with username and password that you may use to review your submission, as well as to modify it within the deadline. Once the deadline has passed, abstracts can no longer be modified by the authors.
- Once your abstract is evaluated, you will receive confirmation by email on September 1st.
- To be granted access to the Conference and the Abstract Publication in the European Journal of Translational Myology, you will need to finalize your registration by September 1st.

SCS Young Investigator Award Requirements

ESNS Young Investigator Awards Requirements:

- ✓ Presenter and submitter must be the same person and less than 30 years of age.
- ✓ The candidate must apply for an oral communication.
- ✓ The selected finalists will present in a special oral communication session.
- ✓ Candidates will be evaluated on creativity, effort, attention to scientific detail and presentation skills. The award committee will take into consideration the similarity between the submitted abstract and the oral presentation.

SCS Applied Science Award Requirements:

- ✓ The candidate must apply for an oral communication.
- ✓ Candidates will be evaluated on creativity, effort, and applicability to sport, coaches or athletes. The award committee will take into consideration the similarity between the submitted abstract and the oral presentation.

The winners will be presented during the Award Ceremony on Friday, November 15, 2019.
